#### Marriage Policy for Our Church

- Marriage is God's idea and is sacred.

- Pastor Lee will present the complete policy in writing for the July meeting.
- Motion by Bill Tubbs: Eldridge United Methodist Church will allow same sex weddings to be
  performed in our facility if the above policy is met. According to the One Church Plan our pastor will
  decide whether he/she will preside over the wedding. Keith seconded. Motion passed.

### Pastor's Report

- Pastoral housing SPPRC fills out Form I annually sent from the conference.
  - o It is the pastoral privilege as to where to live.
  - o In the past, the amount of Housing Exclusion for the pastor has <u>NOT</u> been subtracted from the gross income, so pastors have paid too much in taxes. This will be corrected in the future.
- Nancy Herrin is compiling a list in inactive members. Pastor Lee will contact this list with the help of the TLC group (Donna Eudaley, Sue Cannon, Renee` Nestler, and Joyce Orcutt.)
- For the July meeting, each person needs to research how to get names of new residents so the TLC group can greet them and introduce them to our church.
- Explanation of Pastor's Sundays not to preach:
  - 4 weeks of vacation (Pastor plans to take 1 week every 2 months for the remain of this year.)
  - 1 week for retreat
  - 1 week of Annual Conference
  - 1 week of continuing education
  - 1 week of spiritual renewal.

### Children and Family Ministry - Vacation Bible School

- VBS is a community outreach.
- It will be held the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July from 11:00 a.m. 1:30 p.m. for grades K-6
- Debbie handed out "Save the Date" flyers at the Strawberry Festival.
