Treasurer's Report

Gary and Becky are doing a monthly audit of the books to be sure finances stay on track. We have \$150,00 in the bank, so we are in decent shape.

Secretary's Report:

Gathering Space Acoustics:

Doug Becknell was present to express his concerns about the acoustics. He has been in contact with D.B. Acoustics in Marion, Iowa and has an appointment on August 1 at 2 p.m. to meet with them in our Gathering Space. The company will evaluate and develop a plan to improve the acoustics. Doug said he would make a substantial donation toward improving the acoustics in the Gathering Space.

Keith suggested that the company also look at the sound system in the sanctuary. John Cannon should be invited to attend the August 1 meeting.
