Dear beloved family God,

I hope you are staying warm, safe, and healthy during this snowy and cold winter season. It seems like we have just passed the Advent & Christmas holiday, and now we see Lent coming around the corner.

According to the 2024 church calendar, Ash Wednesday falls on Feb 14. As many of you already know, 40 days Lenten journey begins with **Ash Wednesday**. This year, we will have Ash Wednesday service at McCausland, and we will mark the beginning of the Lenten journey with the imposition of ashes on our forehead, which is one of the most solemn moments both for a minister and members of the church.

The name "Lent" comes from the Anglo Saxon word "lencten" or "lenchthen," meaning "lengthen." So, does this season have something to do with lengthening "something"? Right! As spring appears, along with Lent, days are getting longer.

Lenten season is considered as the most significant time of the church year, as a time of self-examination and reflection, for the preparation of the coming Easter. In the early church, Lent was a time to prepare new converts for baptism. Today, we focus more on our relationship with God. I pray for all of us that our faith will grow further through this Lenten journey together, and at the end of this journey, which falls on March 31, we will become stronger than before as the family of God,


Let me remind you of the exhortation that our Lord gives to us all as the holy season is coming:
